Crock Pot White Chicken Chili

1 1/2 -2 lbs chicken breasts cut in small pieces and place in bottom of crock pot and add:

3 cans rinsed and drained great northern beans

2 cans sweet corn with juice

1 can [10 oz] Rotel tomatoes

1-4.5oz can chopped green chiles

32 ounces chicken broth

2 t. salt or salt to taste

1/2 t. chili powder

1/2 t. cumin

1/2 t. pepper

Cook on high -3 hours or low for 5 hours Then add 2 [8oz each] softened cream cheese - stir

occasionally to melt.

* I like to thicken mine with a little slurry of chicken broth and flour.

Serve with your favorite toppings

Pumpkin Delight

(served at the last club meeting)

First layer:

3/4 c softened butter

1 1/2 c flour

3/4 c chopped pecans

1 c powdered sugar

Mix together and press in regular cake pan 9x13.

Bake @350 for 15 minutes and let cool.

Second Layer:

8 oz softened cream cheese

1 c powdered sugar

1 c cool whip

Blend powdered sugar and cream cheese together, then add the cup of cool whip. Spread on cooled first layer.

Third layer:

15 oz can of pumpkin

1 t pumpkin pie spice mix

3 pkgs (small) of instant white chocolate pudding mix. You can substitute vanilla pudding.

2 1/2 c milk

1 c cool whip

Blend pudding mix and milk. Then mix in pumpkin, spice and cool whip and spread on the second layer.

Fourth layer:

Top with cool whip and chopped nuts if desired.

Pumpkin Cheesecake Bars

(served at the November board meeting) Grease a 9x13 pan Pre-heat oven to 325

Layer One:

20 Graham crackers crushed or approximately 2 c crumbs

2-3 T melted butter

1/3 c sugar

combine till forms a wet sand-like texture and press in bottom of pan - chill.

Layer 2:

32 oz softened cream cheese

1 1/2 c sugar

4 eggs

1 t vanilla

Blend cream cheese and sugar first then add remaining ingredients. Pour half of this mixture onto chilled graham cracker crumbs. Freeze for 2 hours.

Layer 3

To the remaining half of the cream cheese layer, add 1 can (15 oz) pumpkin purree and 1 t pumpkin pie spice. Spread on the cheesecake layer and bake 30 minutes at 325.

Crumble Topping - Layer 4

1/2 c butter (cold) 1 c flour 3/4 c brown sugar 1 1/2 T cinnamon

Cut butter into flour, brown sugar and cinnamon mixture till crumbly. Place on top of baked cheesecake bake another 25-30 minutes. Cool at room temperature and serve! It's even better when it's chilled!
